



Annual Report for 2021/2022

Fundraising for the new project (Idjwi, DRC) started immediately after Haiti project was completed in February 2021 and the project spending was posted online.

£6431.17 from our WoGI Scotland (multicurrency) account was directed to the Idjwi, RDC project via our PostFinance (Swiss) account.

On the field the project became the DRC and Rwanda project. By March 2022, we had paid for 100 x 2000 litre tanks in Rwanda and also the transport of those tanks to Idjwi (where I met them upon arrival).

We had also paid for 150 x 1000 litre tanks and their transport, which never made it to Idjwi (due to corruption), and which we used to start off our Rwanda project (also on lake Kivu).

The difference remaining from the cost of changing the trajectory for transport (DRC to Rwanda) was given to me in cash by ProWater Rwanda (as I'd run out of personal funds) and I reimbursed the WoGI Switzerland account from my PostFinance account directly. This is shown as two refunds to Tasmin on the final reconciliation from ProWater.

This is the conclusion of the report from March 2021-2022.
