Annual Report 2022-2023

Following the distribution of 100x2000 liter tanks on the Island of Idjwi, DRCongo, there was no authorisation received for further tanks to be brought to the DRC from Rwanda, as 'favours' on our behalf were not agreed to.

In August 2022, spontaneous project began in Rwanda, also on Lake Kivu. Two islands whose residents drink from the lake and later on, 4 villages which were associated with the same region (residents who had to drink from the lake due to distance from a clean water point).

150 tanks which had been paid for prior to Tasmin's departure from Europe were distributed on the Island of Mushungo in Nyamasheke district and three villages belonging to the same cell. Kirehe Island received only 7 tanks during this first distribution due to a lack of preparation by the residents.

A further 100 tanks were later ordered and distributed on October 21, on Kirehe Island and two villages in the same cell.

During that time frame, funds from the memorial service of Deborah Franco in the USA allowed us to add another 20 tanks to a village called Matare. Money came via cheque to Helen Cappucino in Buffalo, NY, and were then sent by cheque to Patrick's law firm's holding trust (which accepts cheques) and was finally directed to our Wise US\$ Account. US\$3995.86 (after charges) came via Patrick and a further approx. US\$1000 came in via PayPal.

There is currently US\$1092.57 on the WISE US\$ account.

Our next project will be in the Tulear District of Madagascar in 2024. We are aiming to distribute 500 x 1000 liter tanks and touch 50,000+ lives.
